Cultural life in Lyon is vibrant. The city hosts international events, such as the biannual festivals of dance and contemporary art and the annual festival of lights that takes place in early December. The city also has an impressive cultural infrastructure, with 30 or so museums, 15 libraries, a plethora of theatres and the Maison de la Danse, etc.

Lyon has one of the best football teams in France, among the best in Europe, along with a well ranked basketball team (Tony Parker's Asvel). In 2 hours, students can find themselves skiing in the Alpes or sunbathing on a mediterranean beach in the South of France.
